IHOP'S “STACKS FOR GOOD ACTS” CONTEST IS OPEN TO LEGAL RESIDENTS OF THE 50 UNITED STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA AND SHALL BE CONSTRUED AND EVALUATED ACCORDING TO U.S. LAW. DO NOT ENTER THIS CONTEST IF YOU ARE NOT LOCATED IN THE 50 UNITED STATES OR DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.

**Online/Email entries:** Log on to [www.ihoppancakeday.com](http://www.ihoppancakeday.com) between 12:01 a.m. ET on 2/01/2010 and 11:59 ET on 2/19/2010, and follow on-screen instructions to register and submit to IHOP your 250-words or less story about a good deed either you or someone you know did in 2009. All online entrants must have a valid e-mail address. In case of dispute as to identity of the winner who enters online, the entry will be declared made by the registered user (meeting eligibility criteria) of the e-mail account, and if a prize is won, it will be awarded to that registered user.

Entrants may enter more than once but each entry must be unique and follow the requirements listed or the entry will be disqualified. IHOP is not responsible for lost, stolen, illegible, misdirected or late submissions. All entries become the property of IHOP.

**Entries must meet all of the following requirements or they will be disqualified:**

- Stories must not exceed 250 words.
- Each entry must be original, unpublished, the sole property of submitter, not previously submitted in any other contest and may not infringe upon any third party rights.
- Each entry must include: entrant's full name, age, street address, city, state, zip code and phone number. All entries must include a valid email address.
- At the judges' discretion, entries including unsuitable content or that are in violation of third party rights (including, but not limited to, copyrights) will be immediately disqualified.

**Prizes:** One (1) grand prize winners will receive a one year supply of IHOP's famous buttermilk pancakes (defined as gift cards in the value of one short stack per day for 365 days). No cash substitutions for prizes will be permitted and prizes are non-refundable and non-transferable except at sole discretion of Sponsor. IHOP reserves the right to substitute prize of equal or greater value. Federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. Total ARV for prize is \$1,460.

**Judging:** Judges will select the winners from all eligible entries received. Entries will be judged on three factors: entertainment value (33%), originality (33%) and emotional impact (34%). Winners will be notified by phone, postal mail and/or email on or about 2/23/2010. In the event of ties, the entry with the highest score in the emotional impact category will be deemed the winner. If ties still remain, the tied entries will be re-judged on the same criteria.

By entering the Contest, entrants accept and agree to these rules and the decision of the judges, which shall be final. Winners will be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility and a liability/publicity release and return it by date specified in notification letter or prize will be forfeited in its entirety and another winner may be selected. Return of any prize or notification as undeliverable will result in disqualification and an alternate winner may be selected.
